## **Which option should I take?**

Apply Cobalt liquid to aftermath grazing ground for weaned lambs.  
Use Optigain regularly — every four weeks or so for optimum lamb growth.  
Or alternate with Thrift drench which contains Cobalt, Selenium & B12 only  
For mid season finishing Ewe & Lamb buckets are essential. For Autumn/  
Winter lamb sales make sure that these buckets are available post weaning.  
Finish your lambs at peak prices — get them to market faster!

PS. B12 injection is very useful & inexpensive boost to lamb health and vitality with any of these options.
